



THE BIG PICTURE

The Geneseo Airshow is continuing with a “Tailgate” Theatre style airshow model, with vehicles parking in rows at the flight line and continuing to the rear of viewing area, and adding an area for General Admission viewing area, also along the Flightline. (see MAP above)

Each vehicle in the Tailgate area is assigned a private 20’ x 20’ viewing area for you and your vehicle.

MASKS

Masks are no longer required at outdoor venues. If you feel more comfortable with a mask, you may do so. We respectfully request you follow these guidelines for the safety of others when visiting the restrooms, food vendors, or the Museum or the Museum giftshop.

These regulations may be subject to change if warranted by the State of New York or other health agency.

VIEWING SPACES- LIMITED SPOTS AVAILABLE

Spaces are assigned on a **first come, first served** basis according to your ticket color, i.e. **Red** for showline; **BLUE** for the middle viewing area; and **GREEN** or **TEAL** for Handicapped or oversize vehicles (Over 80” tall and less than 20’ in length).

Your ticket buys the space where you park your vehicle and watch the airshow. If you want to park beside friends, please be in line with them when you arrive at the Airshow grounds.

1 PASS PER VEHICLE.. NO OVERNIGHT PARKING, EXCEPT IN THE CAMPING AREA. PLEASE TAKE YOUR TRASH WITH YOU WHEN LEAVING THE AIRSHOW.

GENERAL ADMISSION

Due to responses we received last year regarding the Tailgate viewing, we have added an additional viewing area that is also on the flightline for **INDIVIDUAL** ticket holders and a General admission parking area. There will be a shuttle service to the GA admission area. For safety reasons, GA ticket holders must remain in the GA area because of moving vehicles in the Tailgate area and individual ticket holders are not permitted to set up chairs or blankets within the Tailgate area. There will be a shuttle available to move people from the GA area to other locations such as the Museum, Gift shop, performing aircraft area, or the re-enactors location and then back to the GA area. You are welcome to bring food and beverages (sorry, no

alcohol or glass containers)with you, but food and restrooms will be available in the GA area.

CAMPING ON THE GROUNDS-LIMITED AVAILABILITY

Self-contained camping is available in a specified area on the grounds beginning at 4:00 pm Friday through 4:00 pm Sunday. The area is away from the normal drive-in viewing area, but still has a great view of the Airshow.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Q. Are the Airshow performances the same on both days?

A. Yes. The performers and time slots Saturday are repeated Sunday. Please note, however, that scheduled events, performers, teams and activities are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. Weather, mechanical conditions and medical issues are all factors that may force a team and/or performer to adjust and/or cancel their performance. Performer cancellation does not qualify for a ticket refund.

Q. Can I bring my own food and drinks?

A. Sure! You can bring prepared items, because no cooking or heating of food is allowed. Also, no glass containers are allowed, no alcohol, please. There will be food and beverage vendors on the grounds.

Q. What does a RED ticket offer?

A. You get a private viewing slot within the area closest to all the aviation action - the "show line" and the first 6 rows. This area is the first rows of the airfield. Even if you arrive late, you're guaranteed a parking place there.

BLUE Tickets are the next 10 rows back from the Flightline.

GREEN and TEAL Tickets are the next 12 rows back and closest to the portable restrooms. The TEAL tickets are reserved for handicapped vehicles and must have a placard.

Q. Can I buy a ticket the day of the show?

A. YES. The **GA** tickets will be available at the gate the days of the show. The deadline to buy a **TAILGATE** ticket for the Saturday show is Friday, June 3rd - unless the show is already sold out. The deadline to buy a ticket for the Sunday show is Saturday, June 4th - unless the show is already sold out.

Q. Do I need to buy a ticket for everyone in the vehicle?

A. Yes and No. If you have a **TAILGATE ticket**, you buy one ticket per vehicle, good for one day's admission -either Sat or Sunday. **GA tickets** are by the person in the vehicle, with children 12 years old and younger **FREE**.

Q. How many people can be in my vehicle for the Tailgate ?

A. You can have as many people as the number of seat belts in your vehicle. This is for safety reasons as well as for your group's viewing enjoyment.

Q. What is my vehicle is oversized?

A. For small RVs and other oversized vehicles — those larger than standard cars, pickups, or SUVs — you buy a ticket for the TEAL Zone. You will have a 20' x 25' tailgate area adjacent to where you are parked.

SETTING UP YOUR TAILGATE OR THE GENERAL ADMISSION AREA

Q. What can and can't I bring?

A. Here's the rundown:

You are welcome to bring:

- Tables, chairs, or blankets
- Small golf umbrellas up to 60 inches across
- Coolers, including food and beverages (NO ALCOHOL OR GLASS PLEASE)
- Service animals (please pickup after your animals)

Prohibited items include:

- Generators
- Glass containers
- POP-UP or poleTents
- Beach umbrellas

- Grills of any type
- Animals, except for service animals
- Golf carts, ATVs, bicycles, skates, skateboards, and roller blades
- Drones
- Kites
- No alcohol, Narcotics or vaping products
- Guns and other weapons
- NO SMOKING ON THE GROUNDS

Please note that vehicles are subject to search by law enforcement while at the airshow.

Q. Are pets allowed?

A. Pets are not allowed, but service animals are welcome with their hosts.

Q. When should I arrive?

A. Airport gates will open at 10AM each day. Lineup begins at 9:00AM. Flying starts around 11:00. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLIER...YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.**

Q. How will I be checked in?

A. Your ticket will be scanned. Have it ready - either a printout or with the ticket image ready on your phone. The parking staff will guide you to the next available parking spot in your designated area.

Q. Can I pick my own spot?

A. Unfortunately, with hundreds of cars, that's not practical. It would create severe traffic issues. We cannot reserve a specific parking space in either the Tailgate or GA areas. Please follow the parking attendant directions.

Q. Do I have to stay in my private viewing area the whole time?

A. You are not required to stay in your private viewing area the entire time and are free to roam the grounds. In the Tailgate area, please

respect your neighbors. The GA Area is first come, first served, so you are free to setup anywhere in the GA area.

Q. Are masks required?

A. We encourage all attendees to wear a mask if you if you feel more comfortable or if regulations from the State or local health authorities change.

Q. Will there be restrooms?

A. Sanitized portable toilets - and wash stations - will be located at the rear of the viewing areas. Handicap Accessible units will also be provided. All units will be sanitized regularly each day.

Q. Can I keep my engine running in the Tailgate area?

A. Please keep your engine use to a minimum. Also, headlights and parking lights should be off at all times. If you have car trouble or an emergency, please notify a roving security officer or parking attendant of an emergency or other situation.

Q. Can I smoke in my private viewing area?

A. No. Not even in your vehicle. There is no smoking allowed anywhere at the Geneseo Airshow.

Q. Can I play music?

A. No loud music, please - don't disturb people nearby who want to enjoy the show. We will be playing music and having a live singing performance throughout the day.

Q. How will I be able to listen to the airshow?

A. There are two ways: Loudspeakers are positioned throughout the Tailgate and the GA areas. The airshow also has its own broadcast signal that you can hear on-site on any FM radio. (Tip: Listen on a portable radio instead of draining your car battery if in the Tailgate area)

Q. Should I wear earplugs? Should my kids?

A. Yes, earplugs are highly recommended - especially for children.

Q. Will we be able to buy souvenirs and is the Museum Open ?

A. Yes. The Museum Gift shop and the Museum Display area will be open with limited entrance to maintain social distancing, and other vendors will be located in a midway between the Tailgate Area and the GA area.

Q. Can I visit the Performing Aircraft ?

A. There will be limited access to the performing aircraft. Please follow directions of the Aircraft maintainers and other security personnel.

OTHER KEY INFORMATION

Q. What are the COVID-19 protocols and other safety policies?

A. Please adhere to social distancing and other health measures and recommendations currently in place by area and state officials and public health professionals. If such injury or death results from the inherent risks of contracting COVID-19, you are assuming the risk by entering the premises. We will balance our dual goals of having healthy, safe GA and tailgater patrons, and presenting an exciting airshow.

Q. Where can I find the schedule of events?

A. Visit nationalwarplanemuseum.com or the OFFICIAL National Warplane Museum-Geneseo Airshow page on Facebook prior to the event.

Q. What if I have to leave before the Airshow ends?

A. Notify a parking attendant or roving security officer before moving your vehicle from the Tailgate area. GA parking may leave at any time. Please note that there is no re-admittance when you leave.

Q. Are there static aircraft and are general aviation fly-ins available for pilots?

A. We are working on the ability to have some static aircraft and some transient aircraft for GA aircraft. Please check back or on Facebook for any announcements.

Q. May I cancel or receive a refund for my tickets?

A. No. Should any local, state, federal, military, or FAA entities determine we cannot host the airshow due to matters beyond our control - such as weather, COVID or other acts of God - your ticket will be honored at the next show.

HOWEVER, you will be able to transfer your ticket to another party or change your day of attendance through the Eventsprout ticketing portal.

Q. Will the airshow performances take place if it rains?

A. The Tailgaters in 2021 should loved being with their vehicles when it got damp and drizzly. But, should it rain, performance times may change or the performers may modify their ceiling levels to work around weather. In the case of severe weather - especially lightning - you'll be notified by FM radio and loudspeakers to remain inside your vehicle or to return to your vehicle from the GA area until the show is cleared to re-start. Some performers may cancel if it is unsafe for them to fly.
